

■ Bouncy House Safety & Operations Guide

Ensuring a Heroic (and Safe) Adventure!

■■ THE GOLDEN RULE: ADULT SUPERVISION

A responsible adult must supervise the inflatable at all times. The attendant must be alert, off their phone, and positioned where they can see all children inside and near the exit.

■■ Setup & Installation Safety

- 1 Clearance: Place on a flat, level surface. Ensure a 5ft perimeter clear of fences, trees, and power lines.
- 2 Anchoring: All stakes or sandbags must be securely fastened. Never move the bouncer once it is anchored.
- 3 Power: Plug the blower into a dedicated GFI outlet. Keep all cords away from water and high-traffic walkways.
- 4 The Blower: Ensure the blower tube is straight and the intake is not blocked by debris or grass.

■ Safe Play Rules

- 1 Size Matters: Group children by similar age and size. Never mix toddlers with older, larger children.
- 2 Capacity: Do not exceed the maximum occupancy (usually 6–8 children depending on size).
- 3 Attire: No shoes, glasses, jewelry, or sharp objects. Socks are required for hygiene and to prevent mat burn.
- 4 No Roughhousing: No flips, wrestling, piling on, or somersaults.
- 5 Entry/Exit: Only one child should enter or exit at a time. Do not jump off the front step.
- 6 Slide Safety: Go down feet-first, one at a time. Ensure the bottom of the slide is clear before the next person goes.

■■ Weather & Emergency Procedures

- 1 Wind: If winds exceed 15 mph, evacuate the bouncer and turn off the blower immediately.
- 2 Rain: If it begins to rain, evacuate children and turn off the blower to prevent the unit from becoming heavy with water.
- 3 Deflation: If the bouncer begins to lose air, stay calm. Help children exit through the front or via the emergency exit (usually a velcro roof or side flap).

■ Prohibited Items

- 1 NO Silly String (it permanently damages the vinyl).
- 2 NO Food, gum, or drinks inside.
- 3 NO Pets.
- 4 NO Face paint or glitter.

■ Pre-Rental Checklist for Customers:

- 1 Area is clear of pet waste and sharp rocks.
- 2 Adult supervisor has read these rules.
- 3 Emergency contact number for the rental company is saved.
